Suggested 5-Night Itinerary

A 5-night stay allows guests to experience all three partner courses while enjoying the best of the Setúbal Peninsula and Arrábida Nature Park.

Day 1	Arrival & First Evening 16:00 onwards — Check-in. Settle into your Room. - Welcome drink and estate walk — discover the 170-acre estate, vineyards and forested hills. 19:30 — Dinner at Restaurant Zimbral. Farm-to-table Portuguese cuisine with regional wine selection. The perfect start: no rush at all.
Day 2	Quinta do Perú Golf & Country Club 07:30 — Breakfast on the terrace. 09:00 — Tee time at Quinta do Perú Golf & Country Club (approx. 20 min drive). Par-72 championship course ranked in the Top 100 in Continental Europe, framed by the Serra da Arrábida mountains. Allow approx. 4.5 hours for the round. - Afternoon — Explore the Arrábida Natural Park: hidden coves, pristine beaches and cork oak forests. A 10-minute drive from the hotel leads to some of Portugal's most spectacular coastline. - Evening — Half-board dinner at Zimbral with Chef's wine pairing.
Day 3	PGA Aroeira Nº 1 — The Pines Classic 07:30 — Breakfast on the terrace. 09:00 — Tee time at PGA Aroeira Nº 1 (approx. 30–35 min drive). Portugal's first PGA National course — the 'Wentworth of Lisbon'. Host of the Portuguese Open 1996 & 1997, and the Open Golf Portugal 2026. - Afternoon — Return to the hotel. Wine & cheese tasting at a local Azeitão property: Moscatel de Setúbal and the renowned Azeitão sheep's cheese. Alternatively, relax at the Slow Wellness spa. - Evening — Half-board dinner at Zimbral or explore local restaurants in Setúbal city centre (10 min).
Day 4	PGA Aroeira Nº 2 — The Challenge Course 07:30 — Breakfast on the terrace. 09:00 — Tee time at PGA Aroeira Nº 2 (approx. 30–35 min drive). Donald Steel's lake-and-bunker course, recently renovated in 2025. Five tee options for all skill levels. - Afternoon — Relaxation at the Slow Wellness spa, a swim in the pool, or a cycling tour through the estate gardens and vineyards. - Evening — Farewell dinner at Zimbral. Toast to the round with a glass of Setúbal Moscatel and the Chef's special recommendation pairing.
Day 5	Departure 07:30 — Final breakfast on the terrace. - Morning — Stroll the estate trails, visit the Convent of Arrábida nearby, or browse Setúbal's Livramento Market (the fish market that supplies Zimbral). 12:00 — Check-out. Transfer to Lisbon Airport (approx. 40–55 min).

Hotel Casa Palmela is a member of Small Luxury Hotels of the World (SLH) and is set within the private estate of Quinta do Esteval, a historic manor whose origins date to the 17th century. The property sits within more than 170 acres of landscaped gardens, cork oak and holm oak woodland, in the heart of the Arrábida Natural Park, one of Portugal's most pristine natural landscapes.

Golf Course 1 - Quinta do Perú Golf & Country Club

Quinta do Perú Golf & Country Club is the oldest golf course in the Azeitão region, founded in 1994 and consistently ranked among the Top 100 golf courses in Continental Europe by Golf World magazine. Located approximately 20 minutes from Casa Palmela, the course winds through a preserved pine forest of more than 300 acres with the Serra da Arrábida mountains as an ever-present backdrop.

American architect Rocky Roquemore designed an 18-hole, par-72 layout that rewards thoughtful course management over raw power. Generous fairways, strategic bunkering, and small, fast-rolling greens create a challenge suitable for all handicap levels. Four of the course's par-5 holes are particularly celebrated, with double dog-legs and well-placed hazards that test even the most experienced players.

The signature difficulty is hole 16: a par-3 of over 200 metres requiring a precise carry over a lake to reach the green - one of the most photographed holes in the Lisbon region.

Golf Courses 2 & 3 - PGA Aroeira Lisboa

PGA Aroeira Lisboa is Portugal's only official PGA National golf resort, located in the Herdade da Aroeira estate, approximately 35 minutes from Casa Palmela. Set within a protected pine forest near the Atlantic coast, the resort offers two distinct 18-hole championship courses - PGA Aroeira Nº 1 and PGA Aroeira Nº 2 - providing guests with two entirely different golfing experiences within the same estate.

In late 2024, both courses completed extensive renovations and were officially rebranded as Portugal's first PGA National courses - a mark of distinction shared with iconic resorts across Europe. In 2025, the resort was awarded Europe's Best Eco-Friendly Golf Facility at the World Golf Awards.

PGA Aroeira Nº 1 - The Pines Classic

The original Aroeira course, designed by Frank Pennink and opened in 1973, is one of the oldest and most prestigious golf courses in Portugal. Nicknamed the 'Wentworth of Lisbon' by the UK golf press, it meanders through tall avenues of mature pine forest where accuracy and placement off the tee are paramount. The course hosted the Portuguese Open in 1996 and 1997, and has been the venue for several Ladies' European Tour events and the European Men's Club Trophy.

The famous 11th hole - a par-4 redesigned by Robert Trent Jones Sr. - begins with a blind tee shot into a narrow fairway framed by pines, followed by a dramatic approach to a green protected by water and bunkers on three sides.

PGA Aroeira Nº 2 - The Challenge Course

Designed by Donald Steel, Tom MacKenzie, and Martin Ebert and opened in 2000, PGA Aroeira Nº 2 offers a notably different character to its sister course. Five large lakes and Scottish-style pot bunkers on the fairways demand precise shot-making and course management. A major renovation was completed in summer 2025, upgrading tee boxes, refurbishing bunkers and redesigning several holes to enhance playability and visual appeal.
